

OSSBN NOMINATING COMMITTEE  
GUIDELINES FOR NOMINATION COMMITTEE PROCEDURES  
(ALL DATES SPECIFIED BY THE BYLAWS)

1. On March 1 the Net Manager shall announce a nomination committee to the membership consisting of the second year advisory Board member as chairman and two members of OSSBN.
2. The purpose of this committee is to prepare a slate of nominees for a net manager for a one year term and for an advisory board member for a three year term. All nominees must be on the current OSSBN roster and be willing to serve if elected. This committee is to have this slate prepared by midnight March 22. It is preferable to try to have at least two nominees for each office.
3. On March 23 the chairman of the nomination committee or his designee should present this slate of nominees to the teller, who was announced on March 22, on the AM net. Once this report is made to the teller, the function of the nomination committee is complete.
4. It is generally not considered good parliamentary procedure for a member of the nomination committee to be placed on the slate of nominees presented by that committee. This in no way precludes a member of the nominating committee from being nominated for an office after the election is taken over by the teller and further nominations are requested from the membership.
